Re: COVID-19 Exposure policy

Please be advised of the following policy with which all students are to comply:

If you are:

Exposed to someone with COVID-19 (regardless of your vaccination status)

AND

Your COVID-19 vaccination status is up-to-date * and NO symptoms:

- You can come to school
- Monitor your symptoms for 10 days after exposure
- Mask use in school is strongly recommended

Your COVID-19 vaccination status is up-to-date * and have symptoms:

- Stay home from school and isolate
- See Isolation policy

Your COVID-19 vaccination status is NOT up-to-date * and NO symptoms:

- You can come to school and wear a well fitted mask for at least 10 days
- Monitor your symptoms for 10 days after exposure

Your COVID-19 vaccination status is NOT up-to-date * and have symptoms:

- Stay home from school and isolate
- See Isolation policy

* When Are You Up to Date?

- If you received or completed your age appropriate COVID-19 vaccination or series on or after 2Sept2022.
- People who received only the Johnson & Johnson/Janssen COVID-19 vaccine are not up to date.

Contact your school nurse for a free COVID-19 rapid antigen test kit or masks. Supplies are limited.
